Its groundbreaking design centres on a glass sphere that infuses the Piazza with light and connects guests with dynamic views of the world. You'll also love The Dome, a cutting-edge entertainment space inspired by the tiered cliffs of Santorini, a port Sun Princess® will visit during her maiden season. She'll also be our first ship able to be powered by eco-friendly Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG), just one of a host of honouring our commitment to sustainable operations.

Maiden Mediterranean: Join Sun Princess® on her 10-day Inaugural Grand Mediterranean cruise that sails from Barcelona to Rome and includes stops in Mallorca, Sicily and Athens, among others.
